

Community High School Spirit Banner Rules

- Must be made of felt.
- Must be ready to hang when turned in.
- It must be predominantly purple and gold.
- Banners must be 6 feet wide by 9 feet long (variations will be disqualified).
- Must contain a rod pocket for dowel or conduit pipe.
- Banners are to be measured from the top of the rod pocket to the bottom of the banner.
- Nothing may extend outside the 6x9 area.
- Items may be appliqued or glued on the banner.
- Any theme will be acceptable as long as sports/class school activity/class-related.
- Must have the class name on it. (Ex. Class of 2022 or Seniors etc.)
- Glitter, paint, etc. may be used to highlight only.
- May use braiding, cords, or other fabric in much the same way that you would use glitter to enhance your banner.
- No paper or cardboard.
- No lights may be used.
- Banners are expected to be original.
- Must be turned in at the library.
- Custodians will hang the banners.
- Banners will be displayed in the gym.
- Judges will be given a copy of the rules while judging.
- Banners will be judged on originality, neatness, school spirit, creativity and attractiveness.
- Points will be awarded for each category as follows: 1st-20 points, 2nd-15 points, 3rd-10 points, 4th-5 points.
- 5 additional points (each) will be given to the banners with the Best Slogan, Best Development of Theme, Most Creativity and Originality, and the Best Use of Mascot.
- Points will be totaled for final ranking

RULES & CRITERIA

- Must be made of felt
- Must be ready to hang when turned in

- Nothing may extend outside the 6x9 area
- Items may be applied or glued on the banner
- Any theme will be acceptable as long as it is sports/school activity/class related
- Must have the class name on it (Ex: Class of 2023 or Seniors etc.)
- Glitter, paint, etc. may be used to highlight only
- May use braiding, cords, or other fabric in much the same way that you would use glitter to enhance your banner
- No paper or cardboard
- No lights may be used
- Banners are expected to be original.

- Banners will be ranked 1st-4th for each of the following categories: originality, neatness, school spirit, creativity, and attractiveness.

- 5 additional points (each) will be given to the banners with the Best Slogan, Best Development of Theme, Most Creativity/Originality, and the Best Use of Mascot
